

ADVANCED BEGINNING CROCHET AT THE SENIOR CENTER JULY 10 & 17 FROM 1 TO 3 PM (NO CLASSES IN JUNE)

CELEBRATE THE FOURTH OF JULY BY CROCHETING A DISHCLOTH IN PATRIOTIC COLORS. YOU MIGHT ALREADY HAVE THE YARN IN YOUR SCRAP BASKET.
