

**ORDINANCE NO. 33-14**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR FULL  
AND PART-TIME CITY LEGISLATIVE POSITIONS NOT COVERED  
BY ANY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT FOR THE YEAR 2014  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, all administrative positions in the City of Avon covered under collective bargaining agreements received, by virtue of those agreements, increases in pay for the year 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, none of the City=s legislative positions is covered under any collective bargaining agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council President, to fairly compensate these full and permanent part-time legislative positions who are not covered by a collective bargaining agreement, recommended an adjustment in their compensation for the year 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, Council, after being fully informed of the various ranges of compensation among all bargaining and non-bargaining unit positions in the municipality finds adoption of the pay increases for its full and part-time legislative positions to be in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining a well-qualified, efficient and productive work force in the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That for the year 2014, retroactive to Payroll No. 1, all full and permanent part-time legislative positions listed in Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by reference, shall be paid pursuant to the schedule set forth therein. In addition, each person holding said position shall continue receiving all other benefits currently being received by full and part-time employees in the City of Avon.

Section 2 - All positions listed in Exhibit A shall be paid pursuant to the directives of the Finance Director. The Finance Director is authorized to increase the annual appropriation to satisfy the additional wage and fringe benefits.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of

Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to establish fair compensation for certain full-time, and part-time legislative positions thereby maintaining a well-qualified, efficient and productive work force in the City; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


