

ORDINANCE NO. 151-15

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH REPUBLIC SERVICES, INC.
FOR THE COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLES, YARD WASTE AND
MONTHLY COLLECTION OF BULK MATERIAL (“BULK WEEK”)
IN THE CITY OF AVON FOR THE YEAR 2016
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City desires to facilitate a recycling program for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue the curbside collection services provided by Republic Services, Inc. during the year 2015, defined in the Memorandum of Understanding authorized by Ordinance No. 147-14 and as submitted for the year 2016; and

WHEREAS, Council deems it desirable and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to authorize the Mayor to enter into said Memorandum thereby facilitating the collection of recyclables, yard waste and bulk material for the year 2016.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON,
LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the City, through the office of the Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Republic Services, Inc., a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and includes the calendar identifying “Bulk Weeks” in 2016, attached hereto as Exhibit “B,” both incorporated herein by reference, for the collection of recyclables and bulk material from residents of the City of Avon through December 31, 2016 and for the collection of yard waste from Monday, April 11, 2016 through Friday, December 9, 2016.

Section 2 - That is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees which resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, Ohio, the immediate emergency being the necessity to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Republic Services, Inc. to provide removal of recyclables, residential yard waste and bulk material in an effort to improve the environment and to reduce the amount of solid waste entering the waste stream and our riparian corridor, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
