

ORDINANCE NO. 26-16

**A ORDINANCE CONSENTING TO THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION
COMPLETING REACTIVE PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE ON I-90
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, Director of Transportation, has identified the need to perform reactive pavement maintenance on a 5½ mile stretch of I-90 from the I-80 toll booth to Cuyahoga County line (LOR-90-10.78-23.33); and

WHEREAS, all pavement treatment will take place within the City of Avon corporation limits; and

WHEREAS, the project is currently scheduled for the Summer of 2016 and;

WHEREAS, Council finds the project to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the motoring public and the citizens of Avon and agrees the City of Avon shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above- described project as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

Section 1 – Consent Statement. The City of Avon hereby gives its consent to the project being proposed by the Director of Transportation, i.e., to perform and complete a reactive pavement maintenance surface treatment on a 5½ mile stretch of I-90 from I-80 toll booth to Cuyahoga County line within the City of Avon (LOR-90-10.78-23.33), is in the public interest.

Section 2 - Cooperation Statement. The City shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the aforementioned project and **no funds shall be required of the City** except that the City agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the total cost for added construction items requested by the City and not necessary for the improvement as determined by the State and the Federal Highway Administration.

Section 3 – Authority to Sign. The Mayor of the City of Avon is hereby empowered on behalf of the City to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above-described project.

Section 4 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity of the City to enact consent legislation to permit

the Director of Transportation to complete the aforementioned project during the Summer of 2016; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
