

ORDINANCE NO. 41-16

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CLASSIFICATION SPECIFICATION
FOR THE CLERK OF CITY COUNCIL AS SET FORTH IN §256.98
OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AVON
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, City Council, in collaboration with the City's Finance Department, desires to amend the classification specification for the full time, unclassified position of Clerk of Council as set forth in the attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Council, after reviewing the Classification Specification, finds the amendment to this full-time, unclassified position to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the amended Classification Specification for the position of Clerk of Council is hereby adopted as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by this reference. It shall be included in and become a part of Section 256.98 of the Administrative Code.

Section 2 - The Codifier is hereby instructed to insert the amendment to said classification specification into Section 256.98.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend the classification specification for the full-time, unclassified position of Clerk of Council before the resignation of the current Clerk takes effect; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
