PRESS RELEASE

Incident: Aggravated Burglary

Date/Time: Wednesday, July 27, 2016 at approximately 4:55 PM

On 07/27/2016, Officers of the Avon Police Department responded to 35470 Detroit Road for a report of an Assault and Aggravated Burglary. Dispatch was advised that Austun York, a 19yoa male out of N. Ridgeville, had entered the residence armed with a shotgun, struck an occupant of the residence, an 18yoa male out of Avon Lake, with the barrel of the gun causing a superficial injury and discharged a round from the weapon inside the residence. York then took a dog from the residence and left.

The call was made to the Police Department's non-emergency phone line at 5:10 PM by an 18yoa male resident of the home. The caller was not at home during the incident and made the call when he arrived home and approximately 15 minutes after York left. At the time of the incident, a 16yoa brother of the caller was in an upstairs bedroom but was uninvolved.

Officers searched the area for York and provided a description of him and a possible involved vehicle to surrounding agencies. York was found by Officers of the N. Ridgeville Police Department around 10:22 PM and detained for our agency. The Avon Police Department took custody of York and charged him with Aggravated Burglary. At the time of this release, York had been transported to the Lorain County Jail to await his initial appearance at the Avon Lake Municipal Court.

Investigation has revealed that this incident is related to York and residents and friends of the resident of the Detroit Road residence. We have no reason to believe that any other citizens should be concerned about similar incidents. The investigation is ongoing and additional charges may be filed.
