

ORDINANCE NO. 114-16

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 21-16
TO INCREASE COMPENSATION FOR THE PERMANENT PART-TIME,
UNCLASSIFIED POSITION OF GENERAL CLERK
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council established compensation for the permanent part-time, unclassified position of General Clerk in Ord. No. 148-14, passed 12/8/14; and

WHEREAS, Council then increased the compensation for this position in Ordinance No. 21-16, passed 2/22/16; and

WHEREAS, Council then amended the Classification Specification contained in ACO §256.98 for the position of General Clerk in Ord. No. 113-16, passed 11/14/16; and

WHEREAS, Council now must establish new compensation for said position; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that the starting pay for a General Clerk be increased to an hourly rate of Fifteen Dollars and Twenty-Four Cents (\$15.24) per hour, together with all other benefits of a permanent, part-time, non-bargaining unit employee of the City commencing with the date of hire through termination; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, finds the increase in the compensation being proposed for the permanent part-time, unclassified position of General Clerk to be reasonable and in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive workforce.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 – That Ordinance No. 21-16 establishing compensation for the permanent part-time, unclassified position of General Clerk shall be amended to increase that compensation to an hourly rate of Fifteen Dollars and Twenty-Four Cents (\$15.24) per hour, together with all other benefits of a permanent, part-time, non-bargaining unit employee of the City commencing with the date of hire.

Section 2 - That effective with the date of hire following passage of this Ordinance, the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for this position as set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Ordinance No. 114-16 (Con't.)

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend Ord. No. 21-16 to increase the compensation for the permanent part-time, unclassified position of General Clerk; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
