

ORDINANCE NO. 33-26

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 65-20 ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE FULL-TIME, UNCLASSIFIED POSITION OF SUPERINTENDENT OF UTILITIES FOR THE CITY OF AVON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council established the full-time, unclassified position of Superintendent of Utilities pursuant to Ordinance No. 118-11 which passed on December 12, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Council established a pay range for said position with Ordinance No. 65-20 which passed on July 13, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Administration, in an effort to be more competitive in attracting and retaining employees, recommends that the pay range be amended and set between Ninety Thousand and One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00-\$140,000.00), together with all other benefits of a full-time, unclassified non-bargaining unit employee commencing with the date of hire; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, finds adoption of the compensation being proposed for the full-time, unclassified position of Superintendent of Utilities to be reasonable and in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive staff for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 – That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 66-20 which currently reads as follows:

Section 1 - That upon passage of this legislation, the range of compensation for the position of Superintendent of Utilities shall be between Eighty-One Thousand Dollars (\$81,000.00) and One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00). All other aspects of the compensation package for this employee shall remain unchanged, i.e., said employee shall continue to receive all other benefits of a full-time, non-bargaining unit employee.

shall be amended to read as follows: (New language in bold print; deleted text stricken)

Section 1 - That upon passage of this legislation, the range of compensation for the position of Superintendent of Utilities shall be **paid an annual salary range of** between **Ninety Thousand and One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00-\$140,000.00)**. ~~All other aspects of the compensation package for this employee shall remain unchanged, i.e., said~~ **In addition, said** employee shall ~~continue to~~ receive all other benefits of a full-time, **unclassified**, non-bargaining unit employee.

Section 2 - That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for this position as set forth in Section 1.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend the pay range for the full-time, unclassified position of Superintendent of Utilities thereby maintaining a well-qualified and productive workforce; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
