

RESOLUTION NO. R-9-26

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO PARTICIPATE IN A
COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION, WINTER CONTRACT FOR ROAD SALT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Section 5513.01(B) provides an opportunity for municipal corporations to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purchase of machinery, material, supplies or other articles; and

WHEREAS, the City of Avon, pursuant to Section 5513.01(B), requests authorization from the Director of Transportation to participate in Contract No. 018-27 for road salt; and

WHEREAS, said purchase, although exempt from competitive bidding by the City, would be at costs competitively bid by the Director of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the savings would greatly benefit the community and further promote the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Avon.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the Mayor or his designee (Safety-Service Director) is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City of Avon, to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) winter road salt Contract No. 018-27 pursuant to ORC Section 5513.01(B) by executing the written agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity for the City to participate with ODOT in its cooperative purchasing program by May 1, 2026 to acquire road salt for the 2026-2027 winter season at a reduced cost; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION
IN THE ODOT ROAD SALT CONTRACTS AWARDED IN 2026**

WHEREAS, the City of Avon, Lorain County (hereinafter referred to as the "Political Subdivision") hereby submits this written agreement to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) annual road salt bid in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5513.01(B) and hereby agrees to all of the following terms and conditions in its participation of the ODOT road salt contract:

- a. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions established by ODOT in the road salt contract and acknowledges that upon award of the contract by the Director of ODOT it shall be bound by all such terms and conditions included in the contract; and
- b. The Political Subdivision hereby acknowledges that upon the Director of ODOT's signing of the road salt contract, it shall effectively form a contract between the awarded salt supplier and the Political Subdivision; and
- c. The Political Subdivision agrees to be solely responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the ODOT road salt contract and agrees that each party hereto shall be responsible for liability associated with that party's own errors, actions, and failures to act.
- d. The Political Subdivision's electronic order for Sodium Chloride (Road Salt) will be the amount the Political Subdivision agrees to purchase from its awarded salt supplier at the delivered bid price per ton awarded by the Director of ODOT; and
- e. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to purchase a minimum of 85% of its electronically **submitted** salt quantities from its awarded salt supplier during the contract's effective period; and
- f. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to place orders with and directly pay the awarded salt supplier on a net 30 basis for all road salt it receives pursuant to ODOT salt contract; and
- g. The Political Subdivision acknowledges that should it wish to rescind this participation agreement it will do so by written, emailed request by no later than Friday, May 1, **by 5:00 p.m.** The written, emailed request to rescind this participation agreement must be received by the ODOT Office of Contract Sales, Purchasing Section email: Contracts.Purchasing@dot.ohio.gov by the deadline. The Department, upon receipt, will respond that it has received the request and that it has effectively removed the Political Subdivision's participation request. Furthermore, it is the sole responsibility of the Political Subdivision to ensure ODOT has received this participation agreement as well as the receipt of any request to rescind this participation agreement. The Department shall not be held responsible or liable for failure to receive a Political Subdivision's participation agreement and/or a Political Subdivision's request to rescind its participation agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the following authorized person(s) that this participation agreement for the ODOT road salt contract is hereby approved, funding has been authorized, and the Political Subdivision agrees to the above terms and conditions regarding participation on the ODOT salt contract:
