

ORDINANCE NO. 82-26

**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD A BID FOR THE
MILLS ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, to address pavement maintenance conditions and to maintain a safe travel corridor it is necessary to repair and re-pave the portion of Mills Road under the City of Avon's maintenance responsibility during the 2026 construction season; and

WHEREAS, the portion of Mills Road under City of Avon maintenance responsibility is defined as the section of roadway, both the north and south sides, beginning at a point equal distant between the Jaycox Road South intersection and the Jaycox Road North intersection thence east to the Westlake Municipal Boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Avon City Engineer has identified the Mills Road Resurfacing Project to include the following: asphalt resurfacing without any additional roadway widening; asphalt pavement planing; placement of a new asphalt pavement surface; partial & full depth pavement repairs; utility structure rim adjustments; curb ramp replacements; pavement markings; and appurtenances thereto; and

WHEREAS, Avon City Council passed Resolution R-13-26 on July 13, 2026, which authorized the public bid for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the public bids were opened and read aloud at noon on July 30, 2026 at Avon City Hall, and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Estimated cost for the project was set at \$1,402,000.00. As such, the bid by Specialized Construction, Inc. is approximately 22.3% below the Engineer's Estimate. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto within [Exhibit "A"](#); and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed each of the Bids submitted and is recommending that the bids submitted by Specialized Construction, Inc. be considered the lowest and best bid for the Mills Road Resurfacing Project, a bid review memorandum is attached hereto as part of Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the Community that the City go forward with the awarding of a construction contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That pursuant to public bids received on July 30, 2026, at Avon City Hall for the Mills Road Resurfacing Project the bid submitted by Specialized Construction, Inc. in the amount of **One Million Eighty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-One Dollars and 30/100 Cents (\$1,089,651.30)** is declared to be the lowest and best bid. The bid tabulation and the bid review memorandum is attached hereto and incorporated herein. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with that entity. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make pavement in said amount from the Mills Road Resurfacing Project Fund No. 440. In addition, the Finance Director is authorized to increase this appropriation by a responsible amount for engineering and legal fees associated with this project.

Section 2- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3- That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to undertake and substantially complete the Mills Road Resurfacing Project prior to the end of the 2026 construction season; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
