

ORDINANCE NO. 18-14

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH LORAIN COUNTY FOR THE
SHARING OF THEIR COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH/RECORDS MANAGEMENT
SYSTEM WITH MOBILE DATA TERMINAL ACCESS AND MESSAGING (CAD/RMS)
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City desires to have access to a Computer Aided Dispatch/Records Management System with Mobile Data Terminal Access and Messaging, otherwise known as “CAD/RMS” Law Enforcement Data System; and

WHEREAS, such a system is available through the Lorain County and the City desires to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the County for the sharing of the CAD/RMS Law Enforcement Data System; and

WHEREAS, Council, after hearing from members of the Administration, particularly the City’s Chief of Police, deems it desirable and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to authorize the Mayor to enter into said Memorandum thereby facilitating the use of the CAD/RMS Law Enforcement Data System by the Avon Police Department.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the City, through the office of the Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Lorain County, a copy of which is attached hereto incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit “A”, to share their CAD/RMS with Mobile Data Terminal Access and Messaging with the Avon Police Department.

Section 2 - That is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees which resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, Ohio, the immediate emergency being the necessity to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Lorain County for the sharing of their CAD/RMS Law Enforcement Data System with the Avon Police Department; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
