

ORDINANCE NO. 22-14

**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE BID FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION
OF A NEW BRIDGE AND APPURTENANCES THERETO OVER FRENCH CREEK AT
THE INTERSECTION OF RIEGELSBERGER AND JAYCOX ROAD
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council, pursuant to Resolution 28-13, passed on October 28, 2013, advertised for bids for the design and construction of a new bridge and appurtenances thereto over French Creek at the intersection of Riegelsberger and Jaycox Roads; and

WHEREAS, the following bids were received:

Company	Base Bid
KMU Trucking & Excavating	\$983,410.00
Schirmer Construction LLC	\$986,700.00

WHEREAS, Service Director, E.L. Robinson Engineering and the City Engineer have elected to perform the base bid and recommend acceptance of the bid submitted by Schirmer Construction, LLC in the amount of Nine Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand, Seven Hundred Dollars and 00/100 Cents (\$986,700.00) as the lowest and best bid received; and

WHEREAS, Council, having reviewed the bids and the recommendations, finds awarding the bid without delay to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the bid submitted by Schirmer Construction, LLC in the amount of Nine Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand, Seven Hundred Dollars and 00/100 Cents (\$986,700.00) is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid received. Said amount shall be transferred from the General Fund No. 101 to the Riegelsberger/Jaycox Bridge Construction Fund 438. Payment in the amount of Nine Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand, Seven Hundred Dollars and 00/100 Cents (\$986,700.00) shall be made from the Riegelsberger/Jaycox Bridge Construction Fund 438, pursuant to directives of the Finance Director. Further, the Finance Director is authorized to increase the appropriation by a reasonable amount for engineering and legal fees associated with this project.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to award the bid for the design and construction of a new bridge at Riegelsberger and Jaycox Roads; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
