

ORDINANCE NO. 40-14

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO INSTALL PLANTERS
ALONG DETROIT ROAD IN THE FRENCH CREEK DISTRICT
IN PREPARATION FOR THE BICENTENNIAL CELEBRATION
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the year 2014 marks the celebration of the City's bicentennial; and

WHEREAS, the French Creek Development Association, a non-profit corporation serving the residents and merchants of the City's French Creek District, has requested Council's approval for the installation of planters along Detroit Road between Route 611 and Route 83 in preparation for the celebration; and

WHEREAS, having reviewed the plans and specifications of the proposed planters, Council deems it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Avon to accept the donation of these planters from the French Creek Development Association as a way to mark the City's bicentennial celebration.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the planters being donated by the French Creek Development Association for placement along Detroit Road between Route 611 and Rt. 83 to celebrate and mark the City's bicentennial are hereby accepted as per the plans and specifications set forth in the attached Exhibit A which are and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to approve the installation of planters along Detroit Road in the French Creek District; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
