

ORDINANCE NO. 124-14

**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE BID FOR A TOWING CONTRACT
FOR THE CITY OF AVON POLICE DEPARTMENT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council, pursuant to Resolution 16-14, passed on September 8, 2014, advertised for bids to enter into a contract with a towing company for services required by the Avon Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the only bid received was from Hall's Towing, Inc., 6451 Avon Belden Road, North Ridgeville, Ohio;

WHEREAS, the Administration reviewed the bid and the various charges specified therein and found those charges to be reasonable; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police and the City's Safety Director, Council finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to award the bid to Hall's Towing, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the contract submitted by Hall's Towing, Inc. and outlined in Exhibit "A" is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid received. Council hereby authorizes the Finance Director to advance funds from the Police Department Fund No. 221 to meet the obligations incurred herein.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to award the bid for the towing contract for the Avon Police Department; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
