

RESOLUTION NO. R-23-14

**A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF
THE NAGEL SOUTH FLOOD CONVEYANCE PROJECT - PHASE THREE
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City hired Polaris Engineering to prepare plans and specifications for public improvements along Nagel Road, south of Schwartz; and

WHEREAS, Planning Commission approved said installation as part of the Schwartz-Nagel intersection improvements and as part of the 2014 Road Program; and

WHEREAS, Council finds it to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to go forward with advertising for bids to complete the construction of the Nagel South Flood Conveyance Project - Phase Three.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for construction of the Nagel South Flood Conveyance Project - Phase One. The project will consist of the following:

Base Bid: Replacement of approximately 1335 L.F. of undersized stormsewer on Nagel Road.

This public improvements will be constructed pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and prepared by Polaris Engineering & Surveying Company, Inc. which shall be on file and open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4- That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the construction of the Nagel South Flood Conveyance Project - Phase Three; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
