

ORDINANCE NO. 65-13

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE BID FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ASPHALT PARKING LOT AT AVON ISLE LOCATED AT 37089 DETROIT ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R-14-13, passed April 1, 2013, the City advertised for bids for construction of an asphalt parking lot at Avon Isle located at 37089 Detroit Road; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director and City Engineer recommends acceptance of the bid submitted by Eclipse Co., LLC in the amount of One Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand, Six Hundred Twenty-Six Dollars and 48/100 Cents (\$153,626.48) as the lowest and best bid received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - The bid submitted by Eclipse Co., LLC in the amount of One Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand, Six Hundred Twenty-Six Dollars and 48/100 Cents (\$153,626.48) is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid received. Payment shall be made from the Park Operating Fund, Fund No. 250 pursuant to the directives of the Finance Director. Further, the Finance

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Director is authorized to increase the appropriation by a reasonable amount for engineering and legal fees associated with these projects.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to award the bid for the Avon Isle Parking Lot Project; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
