

ORDINANCE NO. 99-13

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING REVISIONS TO
THE STANDARD CONSTRUCTION DRAWINGS FOR THE CITY OF AVON
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Avon Codified Ordinance §1248.02, developers and subdividers shall design and construct improvements which will later be dedicated to the City in accordance with the City's "Standard Construction Drawings for Right of Way and Site Development" (hereinafter referred to as "Construction Standards") and any amendments adopted thereto from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer along with other Administration officials have recommended changes to the City's Construction Standards, viz., P-1, P-2, P-2A, P-8 and G-1 all of which deal with concrete pavement standards; and

WHEREAS, Planning Commission considered these amendments to the City's Construction Standards and on June 19, 2013, held a public hearing on said request and by a vote of five (5) to zero (0), recommended approval of the revisions; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that the recommendation of Planning Commission to be reasonable and in the best interests of the safety, health and welfare of the citizens of Avon and deems it desirable that these revisions to the Standard Construction Drawings be adopted and put into use by the various city departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That P-1, P-2, P-2A, P-8 and G-1 of the Standard Construction Drawings for Right of Way and Site Development, adopted pursuant to Ordinance No. 58-01 and 109-05 and as amended from time to time, are hereby revised as set forth in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2 - That the Codifier is hereby instructed to replace any references to previously adopted legislation pertaining to the City's Standard Construction Drawings with reference to this ordinance.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to adopt P-1, P-2, P-2A, P-8 and G-1 of the City's Standard Construction Drawings; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
