

ORDINANCE NO 108-15

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 154-01 THAT
ESTABLISHED THE AVON SENIOR CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMISSION
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 154-01, passed on October 9, 2001, established the Avon Senior Citizens Advisory Commission whose purpose was to advise and make recommendations to City Council and the administration concerning subjects of particular interest to senior citizens and others who share similar interests, e.g., transportation, housing, utility rates and services, employment and other matters related to the health, safety and welfare of senior citizens; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 154-04, passed on September 13, 2004, created the full-time, unclassified position of Senior Center Coordinator, a position under the direction of the Mayor, which plans for and directs services, programs and activities for Avon's senior population; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3-05, passed on January 24, 2005, established compensation for the full-time Senior Coordinator and shortly thereafter the position was filled; and

WHEREAS, since that time, Avon's Senior Center Coordinator has performed all of the functions of the Avon Senior Advisory Commission and administers a budget in excess of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00); and

WHEREAS, after discussion, review and further consideration, Council deems it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to repeal Ordinance No. 154-01 and thereby terminate the operation of the Senior Citizens Advisory Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 – That Ordinance No. 154-01, establishing the Avon Senior Citizens Advisory Commission, is hereby repealed and the Avon Senior Citizens Advisory Commission, which operated under the authority of said ordinance, is hereby dissolved.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to repeal Ordinance No. 154-01 and dissolve the Avon Senior Citizens Advisory Commission; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
