

ORDINANCE NO. 35-16

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH COMPENSATION FOR THE
CLASSIFIED, FULL-TIME POSITION OF INFORMATION
TECHNOLOGY TECHNICIAN FOR THE CITY OF AVON
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 49-11, Council established the classified, full-time position of Information Technology Technician; and

WHEREAS, the position is not presently filled; and

WHEREAS, before the Administration fills the position, Council must establish its compensation; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that the annual starting pay for this position be set at between Thirty Five Thousand (\$35,000.00) and Seventy Thousand (\$70,000.00) Dollars (prorated), together with all other benefits of a full-time, classified employee of the City commencing with the date of hire; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, finds adoption of the compensation range being proposed for the full-time, classified position of Information Technology Technician to be reasonable and in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That effective with the date of hire following passage of this Ordinance, the Administration is authorized to pay the full-time, classified position of Information Technology Technician an annual salary (pro-rated) of between Thirty Five Thousand (\$35,000.00) and Seventy Thousand (\$70,000.00) Dollars as it deems appropriate. In addition, said employee shall receive all other benefits of a full-time, classified, non-bargaining unit employee.

Section 2 - That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for this position as set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of

Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity of establishing compensation for the full-time, classified position of Information Technology Technician; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
