

RESOLUTION NO. R-25-18

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SUBMISSION OF AN
OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) STATE ISSUE ONE FUND
APPLICATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF NAGEL ROAD BETWEEN
MIDDLETON ROAD AND DETROIT ROAD
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the increase of traffic volumes and anticipated future development have necessitated the widening of the roadway corridor along Nagel Road between Detroit Road and Middleton Road; and

WHEREAS, the existing roadway corridor varies from three lanes at the Middleton Road intersection to two lanes and then back to three lanes at the Detroit Road/Nagel Road intersection; and

WHEREAS, the volume of traffic along Nagel Road between Middleton Road and Detroit Road has reduced gaps in traffic to the point that opportunities for left hand turn movements off Nagel Road have significantly diminished and become more dangerous; and

WHEREAS, the widening of Nagel Road between Middleton Road and Detroit Road to a minimum of three lanes will improve safety for the traveling public; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that these improvements may be eligible for partial funding with Issue One (1) Funds from the State of Ohio, Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC); and

WHEREAS, Council finds that these proposed improvements will significantly further the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon and the surrounding communities in providing a widened public roadway with the associated appurtenances including an improved storm water conveyance system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Mayor of the City of Avon is hereby authorized to submit an application and execute contracts seeking State Issue One (1) funds for the year 2018, Round 33, to obtain much needed financial assistance for the public improvements within the City of Avon, to wit: improvements to be known as the Nagel Road Widening Project, Phase 1 with all appurtenances thereto.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

Resolution R-25-18 (Con't)

Section 3 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity support an application for State Issue One (1) funds for the year 2018, Round 33 prior to its predetermined deadlines; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
