

**ORDINANCE NO. 26-19**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE SPECIAL USE PERMIT GRANTED TO  
THE CITY OF AVON/AVON FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION  
AND INSTALLATION OF A 1280 SQ. FT., THREE STORY TRAINING  
FACILITY LOCATED AT 36185 DETROIT ROAD  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to ACO §1262.03(b)(6), the operation of public safety facilities in an R-1 residential district requires a Special Use Permit in accordance with §1280.04(n); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Avon/Avon Fire Department applied for and was granted a Special Use Permit pursuant to Ordinance No.102-02 to construct and operate a fire station at 36185 Detroit Road; and

**WHEREAS**, Council has previously approved amendments to said Special Use Permit in Ordinance Nos. 32-05 and 84-10; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary to again amend said Special Use Permit to include the construction and installation of a 1280 sq. ft., three story training facility to be located 36185 Detroit Road; and

**WHEREAS**, following a public hearing on February 20, 2019 Planning Commission voted to recommend approval of the amendment to the Special Use Permit by a vote of Four (4) to Zero (0); and

**WHEREAS**, having reviewed the plans and specifications as submitted, together with the recommendation of Planning Commission, Council deems it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the community that the Special Use Permit be amended.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That having considered the matter of amending the Special Use Permit to include the construction and installation of a three story training tower to be located in an R-1 residential district at 36185 Detroit Road, Council hereby accepts the recommendations of the Planning Commission and agrees to amend the Special Use Permit for the construction and installation of a 1280 sq. ft., three story training facility.

Section 2 - Conditions. ) That the project proceed pursuant to plans and specifications approved by the Planning Commission on February 20, 2019; and 2) that the Special Use Permit granted herein is conditioned upon applicant meeting all applicable requirements set forth in 1230.09, 1280.02, 1280.03, and 1280.04(n) and 1280.06 (aa) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon. Any expansion, development, enlargement, improvement, change or the like, other than as set forth herein, will require an amendment to this Special Use Permit, with a recommendation of Planning Commission and approval by City Council.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend the Special Use Permit to include the construction and installation of a 1280 sq. ft., three story training facility to be located in an R-1 District at 36185 Detroit Road; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
