

ORDINANCE NO. 28-19

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH COMPENSATION FOR THE
PERMANENT, PART-TIME, UNCLASSIFIED POSITION OF
SENIOR CENTER TRANSIT DRIVER/CDL IN THE CITY OF AVON
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council established the permanent, part-time, unclassified position of Senior Center Transit Driver/CDL in §256.04 of the Codified Ordinances with Ord. No. 27-19; and

WHEREAS, Council must establish compensation for said position; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that the starting pay for this position be established at an hourly rate of Fifteen Dollars and 88/100 (\$15.88) per hour, together with all other benefits of a permanent, part-time employee of the City commencing with the date of hire through termination; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, finds adoption of the compensation being proposed for the permanent, part-time, unclassified position of Senior Center Transit Driver/CDL to be reasonable and in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive workforce.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That effective with the date of hire following passage of this Ordinance or until otherwise revised by subsequent legislation, the permanent, part-time, unclassified position of Senior Center Transit Driver/CDL shall be paid an hourly rate of Fifteen Dollars and 88/100 (\$15.88) per hour. In addition, said employee shall receive all other benefits of a permanent, part-time, unclassified, non-bargaining unit employee.

Section 2 - That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for this position as set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity of establishing compensation for the permanent, part-time, unclassified position of Senior Center Transit Driver/CDL thus enabling the Mayor to fill the position; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
