

RESOLUTION NO. R-11-19

A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF NAGEL ROAD BETWEEN MIDDLETON ROAD AND DETROIT ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the increase of traffic volumes and anticipated future development have caused the Administration to consider the widening of the roadway corridor along Nagel Road between the Middleton Road intersection and the Detroit Road intersection during the 2019 construction season; and

WHEREAS, the existing roadway corridor varies from three lanes at the Middleton Road intersection to two lanes and then back up to three lanes at the Detroit Road (State Route 254) intersection; and

WHEREAS, the volume of traffic along Nagel Road between Middleton Road and State Route 254 has reduced gaps in traffic to the point that opportunities for left hand turn movements off of Nagel Road have significantly diminished and become more dangerous; and

WHEREAS, Per Article VII, Section 2(d) of the Avon City Charter, entitled “Mandatory Referral”, Planning Commission, on April 17, 2019, considered the proposed project and by a vote of Four (4) in favor and Zero (0) opposed, voted to approve the site plan for the Nagel Road widening between Middleton and Detroit Roads per plans and specifications prepared by Chagrin Valley Engineering; and

WHEREAS, the project is approximately 1435-feet in length and will consist of widening Nagel Road to three lanes wide from approximately 300-feet north of Detroit Road to the recently completed three-lane widening of Nagel Road which is approximately 600-feet south of Middleton Road. The project will consist of asphalt pavement widening, asphalt pavement planing, asphalt resurfacing, curb and gutter, pavement repairs as needed, storm sewers, traffic signage and pavement markings. The southernmost 500-feet of the project will not include storm sewer & curb and gutter improvements as this section will be further modified by future roadway improvements at the Detroit Road intersection. The existing traffic signals and lane configurations at the Detroit Road and Nagel Road intersection will remain in place until future intersection improvements occur; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds the recommendation of Planning Commission to be well-taken and finds it to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Community that the City Engineer go forward with advertising for public bids to complete the Nagel Road Widening Improvements Project, Phase 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for public bids for the completion of public improvements within the City of Avon, to wit: improvements to be known as the Nagel Road Widening Improvements Project, Phase 1, with all appurtenances thereto.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the Nagel Road Widening Improvements Project, Phase 1 in order to facilitate completion prior to the end of 2019 construction season; therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
