

RESOLUTION NO. R-15-19

A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE BRIAR LAKES PUMP STATION ABANDONMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Avon, Lorain County, Ohio (the “City”), in order to provide and improve sanitary sewer service to the property owners along and in the vicinity of French Creek Road from 38151 French Creek Road to 37556 French Creek Road and thus improving the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City and to remove from service an existing outdated sanitary sewerage pump station and associated force main along French Creek Road, desires to improve French Creek Road by the construction of an approximately 2,400-foot sanitary sewer from 38151 French Creek Road to 37556 French Creek Road, together with all necessary appurtenances and related improvements thereto, as more particularly described below (the “French Creek Improvement”); and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City, in order to provide and improve sanitary sewer service to the property owners along and in the vicinity of the portion of Century Lane located south of Detroit Road and thus improving the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City and to connect an existing sanitary sewer along Century Lane south of Detroit Road beginning near 37889 Detroit Road to an existing sanitary sewer system along Century Lane north of Detroit Road near 3004 Century Lane by the construction of an approximately 230-foot sanitary sewer, together with all necessary appurtenances and related improvements thereto, as more particularly described below (the “Century Lane Improvement” and, together with the French Creek Improvement, the “Improvements”); and

WHEREAS, the French Creek Improvement and the Century Lane Improvement are so situated in relation to each other that, in order to complete each of those Improvements in the most practical and economic manner, they should be improved at the same time, with the same kind of materials and in the same manner; and

WHEREAS, Avon City Council passed a Resolution of Necessity on April 8, 2019 known as Resolution R-8-19 related to said French Creek Improvement and the Century Lane Improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer in conjunction with Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd. has prepared plans and specifications for said French Creek & Century Lane Improvements in a package hereto forth known as the Briar Lakes Pump Station Abandonment Project; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Community that the City Engineer go forward with advertising for public bids to complete the Briar Lakes Pump Station Abandonment Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for public bids for the completion of public improvements within the City of Avon, to wit: improvements to be known as the Briar Lakes Pump Station Abandonment Project with all appurtenances thereto.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the Briar Lakes Pump Station Abandonment Project in order to facilitate substantial completion prior to the end of 2019 construction season; therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
