

ORDINANCE NO. 98-19

**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE BID FOR A TOWING CONTRACT
FOR THE CITY OF AVON POLICE DEPARTMENT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council, pursuant to Resolution R-26-19, passed on September 23, 2019, 2019, advertised for bids to enter into a contract with a towing company for services required by the Avon Police Department; and

WHEREAS, bids were received from Hall's Towing, Inc., Patton's Towing, and Sugar Ridge; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police reviewed the bids and the various charges specified therein and found those charges to be reasonable (See attached Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police and the Mayor, Council finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to award the bid to Sugar Ridge, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Towing Contract Specifications submitted by Sugar Ridge, Inc., and outlined in Exhibit AB@ is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid received. Council authorizes the Chief of Police or the Mayor to execute same with the approval of the Law Director. Council hereby authorizes the Finance Director to advance funds from the Police Department Fund No. 221 to meet the obligations incurred therein.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to award the bid for the towing contract for the Avon Police Department; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
