

ORDINANCE NO. 72-21

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO
DEPOSITORY AGREEMENTS WITH CHASE BANK, DOLLAR BANK, FIFTH THIRD
BANK, FIRST FEDERAL LAKEWOOD, FIRST NATIONAL BANK,
HUNTINGTON NATIONAL BANK AND KEY BANK
FOR THE DEPOSIT OF PUBLIC MONIES
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, §238.03 of the Codified Ordinances authorizes the Mayor to enter into depository agreements with various banks for up to a five (5) year period; and

WHEREAS, Chase Bank, Dollar Bank, Fifth Third Bank, First Federal Lakewood, First National Bank, Huntington National Bank and Key Bank have made applications to be designated as depositories for inactive, interim or active funds belonging to the City of Avon; and

WHEREAS, each of the banks listed in this ordinance are public depositories providing deposit products in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Chapter 135; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has recommended acceptance of the applications submitted to the City by these seven (7) banks; and

WHEREAS, the term of these agreements will commence on January 1, 2022 and expire on December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Council finds the recommendation of the Finance Director to be acceptable and determines that entering into these agreements will promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in depositing public funds in reputable and secure institutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That pursuant to §238.03 of the Avon Codified Ordinances, the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into Agreements with Chase Bank (Exhibit A), Dollar Bank (Exhibit B), Fifth Third Bank (Exhibit C), First Federal Lakewood (Exhibit D), First National Bank (Exhibit E), Huntington National Bank (Exhibit F) and Key Bank (Exhibit G) for the purpose of designating these banks as depositories for public funds belonging to the City, all of which are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to designate Chase Bank, Dollar Bank, Fifth Third Bank, First Federal Lakewood, First National Bank, Huntington National Bank and Key Bank as depositories for public funds belonging to the City; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
