

RESOLUTION NO. R-37-22

A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE WILLIAMS COURT PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, due primarily to normal wear and tear as well as the development of the adjacent Mass Estates Subdivision, it is necessary for the City to repair, widen, and improve a portion of Williams Court at certain locations within the municipality during the upcoming 2023 construction season; and

WHEREAS, City officials have determined that Williams Court should be improved, where recommended by the City Engineer in conjunction with the Streets Superintendent in an area beginning at the Schwartz Road intersection and then extending approximately 1,875 feet to the south to the northern extent of Williams Court bridge over Schwartz Creek as a project known as the Williams Court Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the Community that the City go forward with advertising for public bids to complete the Williams Court Resurfacing Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for public bids for the completion of the following: Removal of the top portion of the existing asphalt surface, full depth pavement repairs at locations determined by the City Engineer, cold in-place asphalt recycling of existing and widened pavement areas, asphalt pavement resurfacing, reinstallation of impacted pavement markings, maintenance of traffic, and associated restoration. These improvements shall be made pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd. which shall be on file and open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4- That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the Williams Court Pavement Resurfacing Project in order to facilitate completion prior to the end of 2023 construction season; therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
