

ORDINANCE NO. 6-23

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 210.01(e)(6A)(A)(1) & (2) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AVON TO ESTABLISH RATES FOR THE USE OF THE CITY'S AQUATIC CENTER IN THE YEAR 2023 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration, particularly the Recreation Coordinator and the Aquatics Coordinator, has recommended that admission fees be established for the use at the City's Aquatic Center for 2023; and

WHEREAS, upon review by the Mayor and Finance Director, it is recommended that Council approve the amended admission fees for 2023; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon the recommendation of the Administration and after review of the proposed fees, deems it in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the community that these amendments establishing fees for the use of the City's Aquatic Center in 2023 be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That Section 210.01(e)(6A)(A)(1) which currently reads as follows:

Section 4 - The Codifier is hereby instructed to insert the amendments into the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon as set forth herein in the appropriate order, renumbering and/or re-lettering anywhere applicable. All language contained in Sections 210.01 (e)(6A)(A)(1) & (2) not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend Sections 210.01(e)(6A)(A)(1) & (2) to modify fees for use of the Aquatic Center in the City of Avon in 2023; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


