

ORDINANCE NO. 96-23

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL
OF MUNICIPAL PROPERTY
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section 5 of the Avon City Charter authorizes the disposal of City property no longer needed for municipal purposes and having a value of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars or less in any manner deemed appropriate by City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department of the City of Avon has certain municipal property, viz., a 2008 GMC 4500 chassis with a Braun conversion ambulance which may have some market value but has become obsolete, non-functional or is otherwise not being used by the City in the ordinary course of servicing the community; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has identified an entity, (the Village of Grafton, Ohio) willing to purchase the above ambulance for the amount of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS Council, having considered all of the facts and circumstances surrounding the disposal of this property, finds that the letter of intent to purchase the above ambulance submitted by the Village of Grafton to be the most cost-effective way of disposing of this property and is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the municipal property identified herein as 2008 GMC 4500 (asset #453) chassis with a Braun conversion ambulance, having a value of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars is hereby deemed to be property not being used by the Fire Department in the ordinary course of servicing the City.

Section 2 - Council hereby authorizes the Fire Chief to sell the aforesaid property to the Village of Grafton pursuant to the letter of intent attached hereto and marked as [Exhibit A](#) and to present the proceeds to the Finance Director who shall deposit said sum in an appropriate City account.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to dispose of municipal property; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the
