

RESOLUTION NO. R-28-23

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF AN OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) STATE ISSUE ONE FUNDING APPLICATION FOR THE LONG ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, due primarily to normal wear and tear and increased traffic, it is necessary for the City of Avon to repair and re-pave Long Road during the upcoming construction season to maintain safe travel conditions for its businesses, residents, and the traveling public; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has identified a Long Road Resurfacing Project from Detroit Road to Stoney Ridge Road, approximately 5,515 feet in total, including partial and full depth pavement repairs, minor pavement widening, and the complete asphalt resurfacing of the existing asphalt roadway within the project area, see [Exhibit A](#) attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Long Road Resurfacing Project may also be eligible for partial funding with Issue One (1) Funds from the State of Ohio, Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) to partially offset any local funding obligations to the City of Avon; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that these proposed improvements will significantly further the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon and the community in providing an improved public roadway with the associated appurtenances as well as the other noted improvements throughout the project extents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit an application and execute contracts associated therewith from the State Issue One (1) infrastructure funding program for the year 2024, Round 38, to obtain much needed financial assistance for public improvements within the City of Avon, to wit: improvements to be known as the Long Road Resurfacing Project with all appurtenances thereto.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens

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of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to support an application for State Issue One (1) funds for the year 2024, Round 38 prior to its predetermined deadlines; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
